2010 CEDS Project Survey Background

The Eastern U.P. Regional Planning & Development Commission (EUP) is updating its list of regional economic development and public works projects for 2010. We will submit this list to the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) as a part of our 2010 Eastern U.P. "Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy" (CEDS). EDA grant funds can be used for the construction of roads, water, sewer and other publicly-owned infrastructure needed to create and retain large numbers of jobs.

Projects must be listed in the Eastern U.P. 2010 CEDS to be eligible for any EDA grant funds.

We want the Eastern U.P. to be as successful as possible in qualifying for federal grants to help the region compete successfully in the global economy. To this end, strategic regional projects are more important than ever to assist the EUP's recovery from the current global economic downturn. A team from the Michigan State University Center for Community and Economic Development has been assisting us for the past year in re-focusing our regional economic development planning to respond more effectively to current global economic realities.

We will then complete a draft list of projects for the entire region by the end of February and meet with the Regional Economic Development Advisory Committee (REDAC) in early March. The REDAC will review the priority projects submitted for the Region and evaluate them based on the attached criteria.
